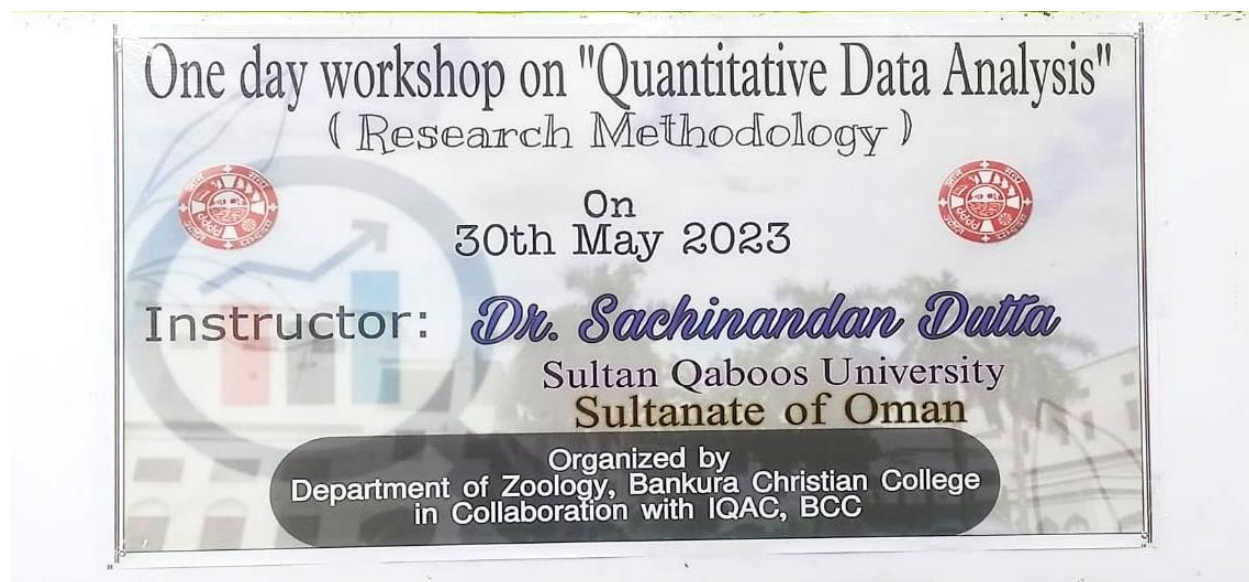


## REPORT ON ONE DAY WORKSHOP CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY, BANKURA CHRISTIAN COLLEGE ON 30<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2023

The Dept. of Zoology, Bankura Christian College organized a One day workshop on 'Quantitative Data Analysis' with the objective to create much interest and enrich further knowledge regarding the said topic amongst teaching, non-teaching staff and students of BCC, on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. Total 73 students from Zoology, Nutrition, Physiology dept. were registered for the workshop through offline mode. It was conducted in Virtual Classroom of BCC. This workshop was organized by our respected Principal Dr. Fatik Baran Mandal, HoD Dr. Anindita Mitra as well as all the faculty members of the Dept. of Zoology in collaboration with IQAC, BCC.



The programme commenced with a brief introduction delivered by Ms Moumita Sinha, a faculty of Dept. of Zoology, BCC at 11.00am, followed by lightening the lamp Dr Santanu Mandal, Associate Professor and Bursar of BCC, followed by Welcome address from honorable HOD Dr. Anindita Mitra, Associate Professor, Zoology, BCC.

The Honorable Speaker for the day was Dr. Sachinandan Dutta, Assistant Professor at Department of Marine Science and Fisheries of College of Agricultural and Marine Sciences, Sultan Qaboos University, Muscat, Oman.

The Seminar was conducted in two sessions.
